Due to renovations being made to Mission San Jose's pool facility - American's pool is being shared by both schools during the 2018 high school swim season. REGISTRATION INFORMATION New Families

- Go to <u>Seals Registration</u>
- Activate your account by entering the email address used on your new swimmer evaluation form
- Once you enter your email you will need to create a secret password
- Follow the online instructions and read/acknowledge/initial all of the information, agreements, and policies
- Review the registration fees & volunteer deposit requirements
- When you have successfully submitted your registration you will receive an email confirmation

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

FAQS | TEAM SUITS & GEAR

Q: Are the team suits custom this year?

A: Yes - this year our swimmers will wear Speedo (Launch Splice Endurance). Suits and cap will include our team logo.

Q: Do I need to purchase a team suit?

A: Yes - each season, swimmers are required to purchase and wear the official team suit. Like other sports such as basketball or baseball - the team swim suit is our "uniform" and should be worn at all meets. The cost of the team suit and a logo team cap are included in registration fees.



Q: Do I purchase my team suit online through Swim Outlet?

A: NO - please do not order the Seals logo/custom team suit online. Because the team will be purchasing the suits for each swimmer, measurements and suit styles will be collected and a bulk order will be placed.

Q: Can I purchase an additional team suit?

A: Yes - you can purchase a non-logo/customized suit at any retail store that carries it. However, we encourage you to purchase through Swim Outlet when possible because free shipping is offered on orders \$49+ and the Seals receive 8% of your purchase.

Q: Will there be dates/times to try on swim suits?

A: Yes. We will communicate additional dates/times when they have been confirmed. Additionally - check out the Speedo Size Charts.

Q: Will there be opportunity to purchase a team parka?

A: Yes - parkas will be available to purchase through the <u>Seals Swim Outlet Affiliate Store</u>. More information is forthcoming.

Q: Will there be opportunity to purchase other Seals gear such as t-shirts, hoodies, hats, etc.?

A: Yes - Seals logo apparel will be available for purchase. More information is forthcoming.

Q: Who should I contact if I have additional questions about team suits and gear?

A: For questions related to team suits and gear - please contact our team Vice President - Angelica.

FAQS | PRACTICE

Q: I have more than one swimmer and they are assigned to practice at different pool locations - can I bring them to the same practice time/location?

A: While it is recommended that swimmers practice with their same age team mates - we also realize that logistics of two different practice locations can become difficult for families to manage. Accommodations can be made for families with more than one child who are not practicing at the same pool. Accommodations cannot be made for families with one child or for families who have all children practicing at one pool. Please contact board@swimseals.com to request an accommodation.



Q: Do I need to notify the coaches if I cannot attend practice?

A: No, if you swimmer needs to periodically miss practice - you are not required to notify the coaches. You should however provide notification if your swimmer will be absent for an extended period of time.

Q: Will the team have dry-land practices?

A: No - the coaching staff has decided that although dry-land conditioning is extremely important to the overall development of our swimmers - the team will maximize our pool facility access. Occasionally our coaches may decide to modify a practice session and will announce that ahead of time.

FAQS | STAYING INFORMED

Q: What is the best way for families to stay up to date on important team information?

A: The Seals have a number of ways for families to stay informed. In addition to the <u>Seals Website</u>, families will automatically receive team emails. Emails are generally sent on a weekly basis. Additionally - there are other channels that parents and swimmers can sign-up for. Visit the Seals Website for sign-up instructions.
