2013 Division 2 Championship Meet Information

Date: Saturday, June 29th

MEET DIRECTOR: MARTIN KOEPPE

Competing Teams: Heights @ SO, Mt. Lodge, Promontory Pointe, Timberwood Park, & Wildhorse

Place: Palo Alto Natatorium 1400 W. Villaret Blvd., San Antonio, 78224

Facility details: 8 lanes by 25 yards-**running each meet in 2 pools** = 16 lanes.

Admission: Free

Meet programs: \$5

Championship Meet t-shirts: \$10 Pre-ordered & distributed to teams before the day of the meet. Shirts will NOT be sold at the meet as Palo Alto wants a 20% kickback on sales.

D&J Sports will sell swim items for a few hours at the start of the meet.

Directions: In South San Antonio take W. Villaret Blvd. and enter Palo Alto campus on San Jose Blvd. Follow San Jose Blvd. till it curves to the right onto Conception. Conception will wind around to parking lots 9 & 10 by the PAC Natatorium and lot 8 if needed. See following for campus map:

Judges, scorekeepers, and league officers can enter the natatorium at 12:00 p.m. to finish set-up. Coaches, parents, and swimmers are not allowed in until 12:30 a.m.

Team seating: Look for your TEAM NAME posted for assigned seating in the poolside bleachers.

Team packets: MEET DIRECTOR, MARTIN KOEPPE, will be at the pool to give team reps or head coaches a meet packet. Packet includes 8 copies of heat sheets, pink & blue relay cards for written changes, a white individual event withdrawal form, and volunteer badges.

Relay cards: Coaches making name changes on relay teams must do so **NLT 1:15 p.m. prior to the meet's beginning** and **given only to the Head Scorekeeper, Regina Prewitt-Campbell**. If relays are to be swum as entered, then no relay change card is necessary.

Spectator Seating: There are ample poolside seats for spectators—some chairs with backs and bleacher seating as well. **PALO ALTO WILL NOT ALLOW CHAIRS TO BE SET UP!**

Concessions: Palo Alto will run the **CASH ONLY** concessions stand--not our league.

Meet entries: Teams may enter only 2 relay teams per age group for the Championship Meet.

Swimmers can be entered in no more than 4 total events. There is no limit on the number of entries for individual events from each team. Teams may download the meet file from the web site under Hy-Tek Downloads. **All Division 1 entries are due to Donna Witt no later than 12 noon on THURSDAY, 6/20th.**

All-Star Meet Qualifiers: The 1st place winners for both **individual and relay events** from each Division automatically qualifies for the All-Star Meet followed by the next 5 fastest times from **any** division. If a swimmer cannot attend the July 2nd All-Star Meet, the lane remains empty. At least 3 out of the 4 placing swimmers on a relay team must swim at the All-Star Meet or the lane remains empty. No meet entries need to be submitted. Rain date is on Tuesday, July 9th if needed.

Warm-ups: 1 – 1:45 p.m.-DIVIDE SWIMMERS INTO WARM-UP GROUPS

Assigned warm-up lanes: Heights @ SO—**North** Pool lanes 1-3, Wildhorse—**North** Pool lanes 4-7, Promontory Pointe—**North** Pool lane #8 & **Middle** Pool lanes 1-2, Timberwood Park—**Middle** Pool lanes 3-5, Mt. Lodge—**Middle** Pool lanes 6-8

Officials' meeting: 1:20 p.m.

Timers' meeting: 1:30 p.m. location to be announced for **ALL TIMERS**

Coaches meeting: 1:45 p.m. Location to be announced

Meet begins: 2:00 p.m. – Ends approximately 4:30 p.m.

LIFEGUARDS: No one is allowed to interfere with the lifeguards on duty in any manner.

READY BENCH: Located in chairs either behind the starting blocks or on the side of the pool. Team coaches/or a designated parent volunteer are responsible for directing swimmers to the correct starting blocks, but are not allowed behind the blocks.

Swimmers ages 11 and older and ALL Medley Relays will compete in the North Pool with starting blocks and **touch pads**.

Children 10 & U swimming 25's dive from the deck of the MIDDLE POOL, and swim towards the **TOUCH PADS**.

Parent Volunteers: Each team provides parent volunteers to work at the meet as timers, program sales, runners, scorekeepers, ribbons & awards area, line-up personnel for the lanes of both pools, and clean-up crew after the meet ends. Teams also assign parents to assist younger swimmers to the restrooms, calling swimmers ready for their events, and assist with **cleaning up the bleachers & pool area at the end of the meet. NO ITEMS CAN BE LEFT BEHIND! The bleacher and pool area must be free of all items and litter!**

Awards: Teams - 1st – 3rd place banners

Swimmers - 1st – 3rd place medals, and 4th - 16th ribbons.

High point awards: presented at the All-Star Meet to the boy and girl from each age group (EXCLUDING 6 & U as they usually swim only two events) earning the most points for his/her team in the individual & relay events at the Division Championship Meet.

Rules:

1. **The MSSSL agrees to leave the buildings in good and clean order.**
2. **The MSSSL agrees that no offensive language, gambling, firearms, weapons, alcohol, controlled substances, other intoxicants of any kind, or tobacco will be permitted to be used.**
3. **The MSSSL agrees that no disorderly or disruptive behavior takes place at PAC.**
4. **Teams/parents will abide by helping enforce the NO RUNNING safety rule. The pools' tile decking is extremely slippery when wet.**
5. **Swimmers will not be allowed in the extra pool during the meet.**
6. **No GUM or glass containers.**
7. **SMOKE FREE ZONE.**
8. **NO OUTSIDE CHAIRS ALLOWED IN THE NATATORIUM TO BE SET UP AROUND THE POOL! There is ample seating for everyone at this facility.**
