



Chatsworth Waves Swim Team 2013 Registration Form

The Chatsworth Swim Team is open to all children – inside and out of the subdivision – ages 4*-18. Team registration fees are per child and include a team t-shirt, ribbons, team medal, daily practices, and participation in five league meets. Funding for the team is not provided by the Chatsworth Homeowners Association. The team is self-sufficient and relies heavily on parent participation. All programs are funded from registration fees and concession profits.

2013 Fees

- \$95 – First Swimmer
- \$85 – Each additional swimmer per family (Big family? Swim 3 & 4th is FREE)
- *\$65 - Little WAVES (swimmers 4 & 5 years old who miss 5/31/13 cut-off for meets)
- \$10 – Non-Chatsworth resident fee per family

Teens 13 years & older only \$25!

Fees include practice with qualified instructors, team t-shirt, meet ribbons, medal, and participation in 5 Cobb County meets.

	It is a mandatory requirement that each swimmer have ONE parent/guardian to work a shift at each of the five meets		
	Timers	Preferred shift: ___ 6pm-7:30pm ___ 7:30pm- to close	Equipped with an electronic timer and assigned to a lane, the timer captures the finish time on the pin/blue sheets & hands it to the runner.
	Line Judges	Preferred shift: ___ 6pm-7:30pm ___ 7:30pm- to close	Sit poolside along with a judge from the other team and record swimmer placement on event cards.
	Runners	Preferred shift: ___ 6pm-7:30pm ___ 7:30pm- to close	Collect event cards from timers after each event and deliver to the scoring table.
	Scoring Table & Ribbons	Preferred shift: ___ 6pm-7:30pm ___ 7:30pm- to close	Calculate team scores, prepare meet reports, and ribbons for each swimmer for each event. There may be some training required on swim team management software.
	Concessions	Preferred shift: ___ 6pm-7:30pm ___ 7:30pm- to close	Duties include set-up, food prep, and sales for the WAVES concessions stand for home meets (there are 3 home meets).
	Bullpen Mom/Dad	Preferred shift: ___ 6pm-7:30pm ___ 7:30pm- to close	Assure that your designated group of boys or girls, by age group, get to their events on time and are in the correct lane.
	Clean-up	ALL families are expected to help with clean-up at the end of home meets.

Swimmers receive meet ribbons and enjoy a practice with breakfast and fun pool games. The FUN DAY coordinators buy supplies (juice, cups, muffins, condiments), arrange for pick-up of donated bagels from Einstein's the night before, staff the event, set-up and break-down.
___ Yes, I'd LOVE to help	Banquet Coordinator(s) (4 needed)	The banquet is our last—and biggest—event of the season. The coordinator recruits and supervises a team of volunteers to create invitations, coordinate food, collect fees, set up buffet tables and food, serve and clean-up.
FILLED! Mandy Fischer	Volunteer Coordinator	Responsible for the placement and training of all parent volunteer assignments. The Volunteer Coordinator will—to the best of her ability—place all volunteers in preferred positions and publish the volunteer schedule the day of the meet.
___ Yes, I'd LOVE to help	Concessions Coordinator (4 needed)	Responsible for food selection & purchase, pricing, set-up, volunteer management and overall management for the WAVES concession stand so that it offers quality meals and it profitable.
