Old business

City Meet wrap up—thanks to all coaches and GKAISA supporters for making city meet a huge success. Issues were minimal during the meet weekend. Highlights—new wrist bands for coaches went well. Green shirts did a great job. Radios instead of sound system tried for first time. Saved 66% going with FM transmitter instead of sound equipment. Looking into going to internet broadcast. Working out any kinks for 2013. Tent set up was a success. Thanks to Harry Whiteside for organizing and plotting out tent placement. Compliments on Meet Mobile. Clerk of Course—Craig Horsley—set up of CoC was better. Suggestion to try to get as many seasoned workers for CoC as possible. Overall CoC went very well. Balloon Drop was a hit with the kids. Chris Scollay and the aquatic center life guards are to thank for the balloon idea. We are striving to make the meet enjoyable for the swimmers and their families and spectators. Swamp coolers will hopefully be fully operational next City meet. Please work as a team to make sure all swimmers are entered prior to meet. Looking at a Parent Pick up Area for younger swimmers for safety of kids. Intro of leagues for 2013. Website is being updated.

New business

Rule changes—swimmer release forms. Swimmer release forms must be taken to every meet. Online roster is time stamped and dated. Roster needs to be updated online one day prior to each meet if new swimmers are added. If roster is not updated, delinquent club may not host or participate in any GKAISA interclub swim meets until the required information is posted. Any meets held prior to submitting the required information shall be forfeited. Failure to update the online swimmer roster 1 day prior to the meet will result in the swimmer being ineligible to swim in the meet.

Vote to approve the changes with the amendment of adding consequences voted and approved. Will be submitted for second vote at Spring meeting.

Motion to accept correction of fees on website voted and approved. Will be submitted for second vote at Spring meeting.

Blocks for 10 and unders at City Meet for finals—no vote necessary, meet management issue, but would like feedback from members. Finals only at this time. Prelims maybe in future. Possible benefit besides

more opportunity to break records would be possibly safer for swimmers to come off blocks as opposed to pool deck. Electronics side of this is possible, but blocks on both sides is not feasible for the facility to accommodate for prelims. Thoughts are that it would be easier for the younger swimmers to line up if lining up behind blocks. Workers would change sides like in regular season meets. Consistency concern with doing one option for prelims and different option for finals may be confusing for swimmers. Exit flow would work well with younger swimmers going off blocks.
