Wynfield Forest Dolphins Swim Team!!

What is the Swim Team?

It is 7 weeks of fun and a great way for swimmers to gain strength, endurance, and confidence in the water!! For the mere cost of registration swimmers and their parents get:

- 1. 7 weeks of swim instruction by our qualified Wynfield Forest and Wynfield Creek resident coaches.
- 2. The chance to make new friends and socialize with children and other parents living in Wynfield Forest and Wynfield Creek.
- 3. Friendly swim competitions with other area neighborhoods.
- 4. Social events for the swim team and coaches (i.e. End of Year banquet and special practices)

Wynfield Forest Swim Team is a part of the North Meck Swim League. We will compete against Birkdale, MacAulay, Wedgewood, Stephen's Grove/Latta Springs, and Cowan's Ford.

There are 4 to 5 swim meets during the season and a Championship Meet.

My child is not a good swimmer or is a beginner:

- 1. Children that can swim the length of the pool using any stroke are qualified to be on the team.
- 2. Our coaches will take it from there. Our swimmers receive the instruction they need to learn all four swim strokes (freestyle, backstroke, breast stroke and butterfly).
- 3. Our swim league has a '6 and under' category for beginner swimmers. This age group swims freestyle and backstroke and may be entered in a freestyle relay. The '6 and under' swimmers are normally finished swimming by 7:30 pm at swim meets.

My child swims year-round already:

- 1. Year-round swimmers can participate in the Wynfield Forest Swim Team
- 2. Swim practice for MAC and NOMAD will count toward the Wynfield Forest swim team practices.

What is the time commitment?

- 1. Practices are 5 days a week (except for holidays) and are 45 minutes long. They will be in the evenings until June 9th and the mornings beginning June 12th.
- 2. There will also be two evening practices per week offered. These practices are ONLY to be used when your swimmer needs to miss a morning practice for some reason.
- 3. There are 4 to 5 swim meets (one to two a week) during the season and a Championship Meet on July 8, 2017. Swimmers are to arrive for the meets no later than 5:15 pm and North Meck Swim League regulations require that all meets be completed by 10 pm.

Family Vacation/Summer Camp:

- 1. Going on Vacation? Just sign your swimmer out of any meets during the week you are gone.
- 2. Going to Summer Camp? Two evening practices will be offered per week for those who cannot make it in the morning.
